Sample Bequest Language

A gift to the Brandywine Valley SPCA in your will or revocable trust helps us create the future of animal care. A bequest is easy to arrange, will not alter your current lifestyle in any way and can be easily modified to address your changing needs.

Residual Bequest Language

A residual bequest comes to us after your estate expenses and specific bequests are paid:

I give and devise to the Brandywine Valley SPCA, all (percentage) of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).

Specific Bequest Language

Naming the Brandywine Valley SPCA as a beneficiary of a specific amount from your estate is easy:

I give and devise to the Brandywine Valley SPCA, the sum of \$_____ (or asset) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).

Contingent Bequest Language

The Brandywine Valley SPCA can be named as a contingent beneficiary in your will or personal trust if one or more of your specific bequests cannot be fulfilled:

I give and devise to the Brandywine Valley SPCA, the sum of \$_____ (or asset) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).
